



Webberville Consolidated Drain Project Construction Notice/Temporary Water Shut Off/Clark and Oak Streets September 23, 2020

Dear Webberville Village and Leroy Township Resident:

Water service to households will be interrupted temporarily to the following properties along Clark Street south of Walnut all the way to its ending and then west on Oak Street from its confluence at Clark Street to South Main Street, **please see location map on reverse side**. This temporary interruption will be starting **Friday morning, September 25th, after 8:00 AM and should continue until at least 2:00 PM that day, duration of the interruption is dependent on success of the work.** The water main is being excavated and lowered to facilitate storm construction and will need to be turned off to accomplish this work. **To facilitate toilet flushing during the water shutoff, homeowners should fill their bathtubs with water prior to the shut off and fill their toilet tanks manually from that source with a pail until service is returned.**
