



## Webberville Consolidated Drain Project Construction Notice/Temporary Water Shut Off/E. Walnut Street April 27, 2021

Dear Webberville Village and Leroy Township Resident:

Water service to households will be interrupted temporarily to the properties along E. Walnut Street between S. Main Street and South Clark Street, **please see location map on reverse side**. This temporary interruption will be starting **Thursday morning April 29<sup>th</sup>, after 8:00 AM and should continue until at least 2:00 PM that day, provided things go well and weather permits.** The water main is being lowered to facilitate storm construction and will need to be turned off to accomplish this work. **To facilitate toilet flushing during the water shutoff, homeowners should fill their bathtubs with water prior to the shut off and fill their toilet tanks manually from that source with a pail until service is returned. It is also recommended that you fill several gallon jugs of water for drinking and cooking purposes based on your needs.**
